

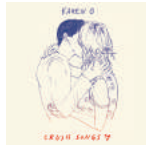
Karen O, Crush Songs

New York scenesters the Yeah Yeah Yeahs have carved out a singular path in music over the past 14 years: always the same, but always different. It helps that they're all brilliant performers with a star frontwoman in the form of Karen Lee Orzolek, better known as Karen O. With wild offstage antics and a memorable wardrobe (outfits have included a gold kimono, a Peter Pan onesie and a vampire cape - and those are just the ones we can approximately describe), it was only a matter of time before she released a solo album. *Crush*

Songs follows on from her Oscar-nominated *The Moon Song*, written for one-time boyfriend Spike Jonze's film *Her*. *Crush Songs* is pared-down, acoustic and heartfelt. 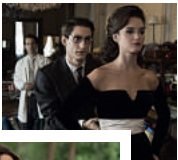


Double take

Meet Analeigh Tipton (above), who swapped the ice rink for fashion shoots at 16, coming third in a cycle of *America's Next Top Model* before making the move to acting. Nowadays, you can spot her in films with Ryan Gosling (*Crazy, Stupid, Love*) and, more recently, as Scar-Jo's bestie in summer sci-fi flick *Lucy*.



SOFIA BOUTELLA

Sofia (right) may only just be making a name for herself on the big screen - watch out for her in *Monsters: Dark Continent* (out 28 November) - but she already owns the dance floor. Working predominantly as a hip-hop dancer, Sofia is widely recognisable from her slick solo in the form-twisting Nike ad campaigns.
